


WELCOME TO THE FEBRUARY 2016 EDITION OF THE CARAVEL NEWSLETTER

DeliverMyStrategy DEVELOPMENT COMPLETE

We are pleased to announce that we have now completed the development of our DeliverMyStrategy approach that has been developed to capture our delivery IP into a product that can be used by other organisations. The software that supports this has now been in use for 2 years and is ready for full deployment.

The Caravel approach has delivered an 80% delivery success rate (compared with 52% success on average for industry) for strategic initiatives, projects and change within the complex infrastructure space.



The software is the result of more than 2 years of development by the Company including documenting the various approaches we take, creating the underlying models, developing the user interfaces to capture and display information and fine tuning the delivery of the information. The full system is available from a secure private cloud over the internet and the dashboard is also available for iOS and Android platforms to maximise the value and availability of the system.

With the software and supporting documentation now developed, we are moving into our test phase to validate the translation of the Caravel approach into a business other than Caravel. This phase is being managed using an "Invitation to Participate" to organisations with the desire to improve their delivery performance. As a registered AusIndustry organisation, our research into Delivery Governance has been recognised and we are proud to be identified as the thought leaders in this space.

We are also excited about the support we have received from both the Melbourne Business School and Macquarie University and we are currently in discussion with a number of industry bodies and commercial organisations about participation in the trials.

CARAVEL PRESENTS TO THE WARREN CENTRE FOR ADVANCED ENGINEERING

In October 2015, Paul Myers delivered a presentation to the Warren Centre for Advanced Engineering as part of their IP30 initiative. The IP30 stands for "Infrastructure Productivity 30" with the 30 reflecting the \$30 Billion estimated annual wastage as a result of poor project success rates (as reported by Caravel to Infrastructure Australia in our 2013 report).

Paul delivered a presentation on the changes we need to make to innovate for greater success in delivery of infrastructure. Paul's presentation provides a logical and deployable approach for significantly improving our delivery capabilities – but we cannot do this without innovating. And innovation is not just about "THINKING" it is as much about "DOING".
